Dear Neighbor:

You are receiving this letter because you are a landowner that may potentially be affected by a pipeline expansion being considered in your area.

Florida Gas Transmission Company LLC ("FGT") is considering an expansion of its existing interstate natural gas pipeline to provide additional natural gas to the State of Florida to meet the increasing demand for energy from the growing population.

This expansion would include construction of a new pipeline along the company's existing right of way, as well as in some new areas. While the company has a general route, the specific route has not been selected, which is why we are asking for your cooperation.

You will soon be receiving a call from a right of way representative to request permission to do a survey on your property. A survey crew will be following up shortly after the first of the year. The survey will help determine the specific route of the proposed project.

FGT is an interstate natural gas pipeline that is part of the nation's vital energy infrastructure. As such, the company is regulated by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). If FGT continues with this project, a formal application filing will be made with FERC so they can review the project and apply the appropriate conditions prior to issuance of a permit.

FGT plans to initiate a request to participate in the FERC's Pre-Filing Process. The first step in this process will be a meeting with the Commission. The company then plans to hold open house meetings sometime after the first of the year to answer your questions about the proposed project. You will be notified about a meeting in your area.

Florida Gas Transmission operates a 5,000-mile pipeline system from south Texas to Florida with service to over 250 delivery points with connections to over 50 natural gas fueled electric generation plants. The Florida customer base includes electric utilities, independent power producers, industrial customers and local natural gas distribution companies.
