Enclosed herewith for filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") is Florida Gas Transmission Company, LLC's ("FGT") application pursuant to Section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act, as amended, and Parts 157 and 284 of the Commission's Regulations, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity and authority to acquire natural gas pipeline facilities, requesting authorization to construct, own, operate and maintain certain natural gas transmission facilities to provide transportation services. The pipeline project, referred to as the "Phase VIII Expansion Project", includes the construction of approximately 483.2 miles of multi-diameter pipeline and related facilities, including additional mainline compression horsepower totaling 213,600. The project will provide an annual average of 820,000 MMBtu/day of additional firm transportation service.


